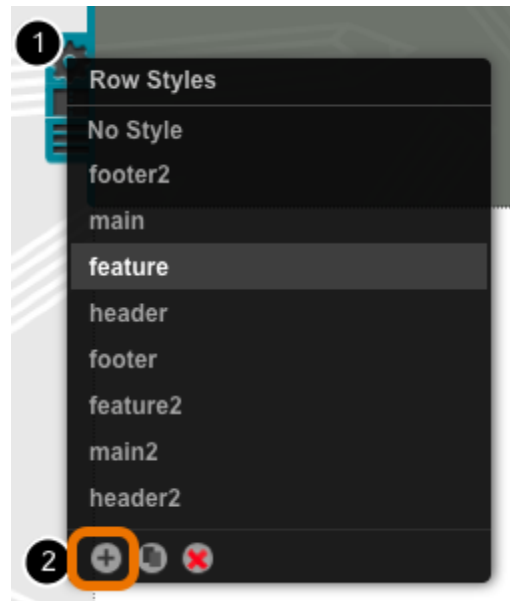


Change the colour of a row or column

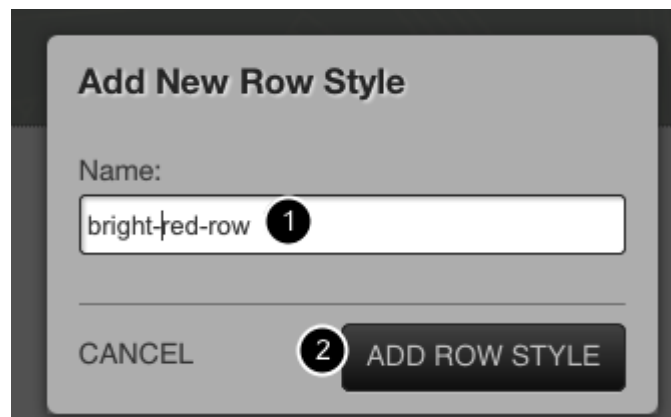
How to set a specific colour for a row or column

Use styles to set colours

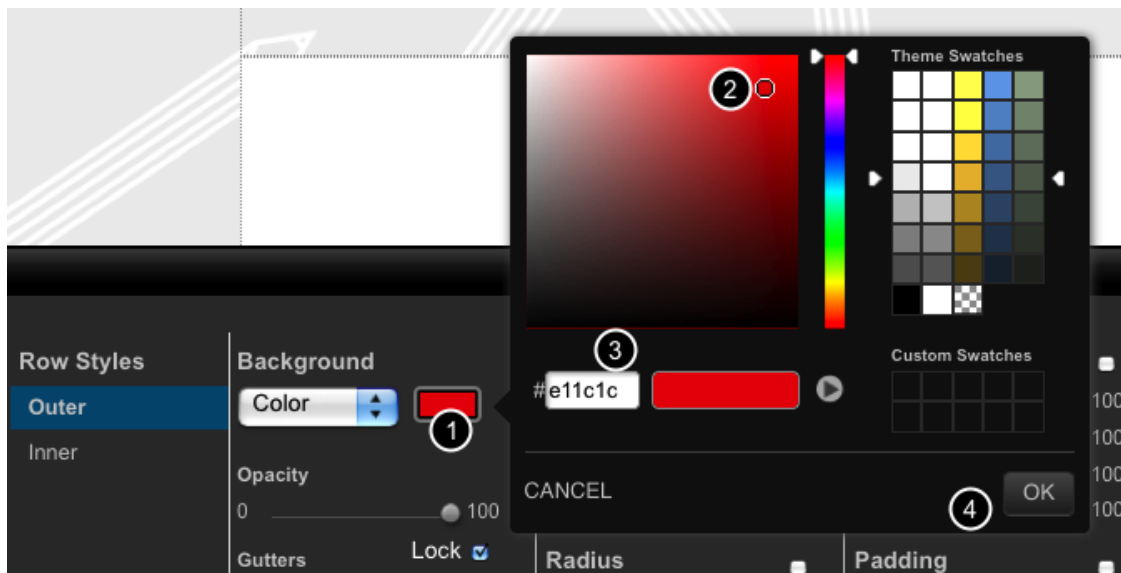


You can set the colour of a row or column by creating a style.

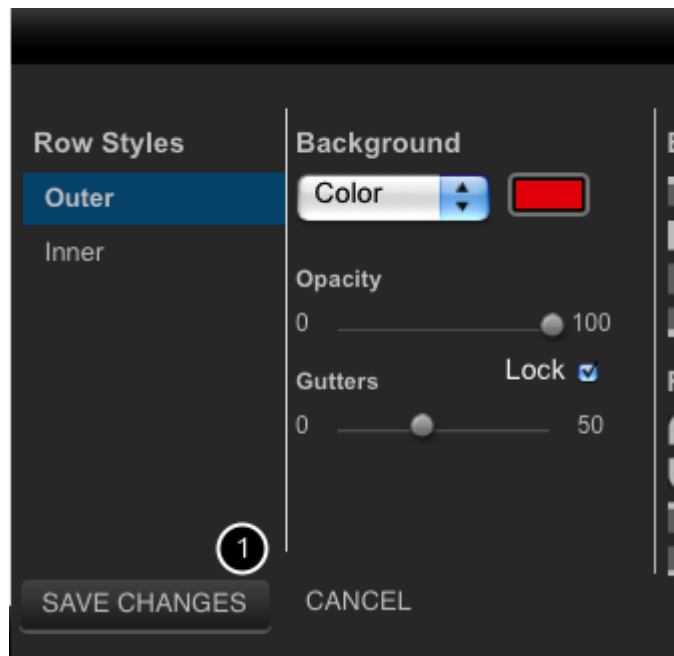
To create a row style, click the **row settings button (1)** and then click the **add style button (2)**.



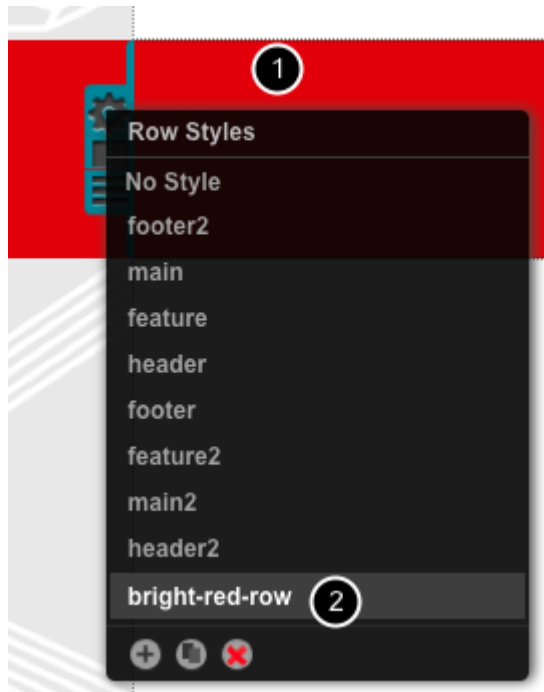
Give the row a meaningful name (1) and click the **Add row style button (2)**



Click the **colour chip (1)** and then select a colour. You can click and drag on the **colour selector (2)** or paste a **hex value (3)**. Click the **OK button (4)** to confirm the selection.

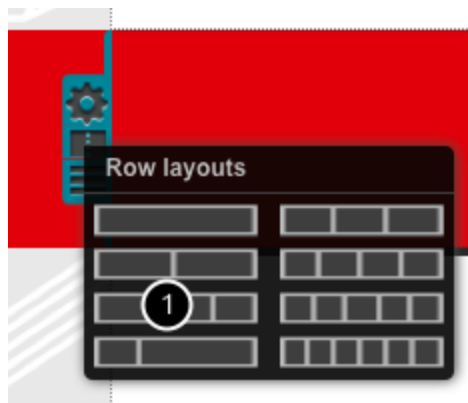


Click the **save changes button (1)**

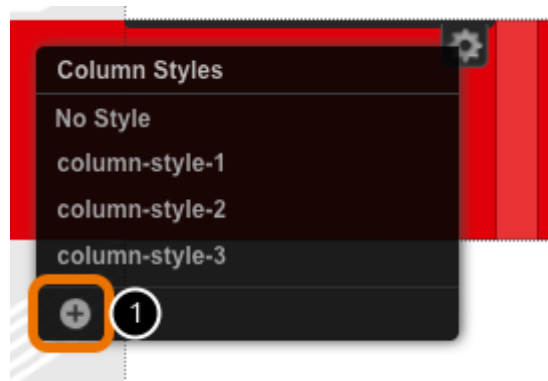


The colour will be applied to the row (1). The new style will appear in the **style list (2)** and can be applied to any other row.

To change the colour of a column



To split a row into columns use the row split menu



Click the add style button (1) and then follow the same procedure as for a row.
